Optional Kaikoura Activities



Kaikoura Fishing

- 2 hours' crayfishing and fishing: good for the quick trip to hopefully get a bit of crayfish and catch some great fish, all while enjoying the beautiful coastal views. Great for first timers!
- The experienced crew will bait your hooks, remove, and process the fish for you.
- All fishing gear is provided, and the Weir tour guides will cook any catch for you!
- **Cost: \$145pp**



Kaikoura Kayaks

- This adventure around the beautiful coastal waters 100% guarantees seal viewing with chance encounters with dusky dolphins and blue penguins.
- The guided wildlife kayaking tour is suitable for all ages and abilities and doesn't require any previous kayaking experience, and all equipment is provided.

Swim with the Dolphins (highly recommended)

Health & Safety Information including COVID-19

Payments, Cancellations & Refunds

A deposit is required at the time of booking to confirm your seat. The balance of all payments must be received by Weir Tours NZ prior to or on the date specified for final payment. Payments are available to be made by Cash, Eftpos / Credit or Direct Debit via the account number supplied on the payment form. Please note if paying via credit card you will incur a fee of 3% on top of original price. Weir Tours NZ reserves the right to amend or reschedule the tour due to the result of circumstances outside the company's control. Weir Tours NZ also reserves the right to cancel the tour due to insufficient numbers and in this instance a substitute date may be offered, or a full refund will be made available. Tour Prices exclude drinks, travel insurance or items of personal nature.

Travel Insurance

0–14 Days prior to tour commencement you will forfeit 100% of your tour price (No Refund)
